Get access to the Agent Portal APIs

Clicking on the APIs tab will show the API Catalog with an API Group that your application can be subscribed to gaining access to a suite of APIs.



To view the API documentation, click on the Group Details button.



Click the "Request Access" button to subscribe your app to use the API Product.

When you click on the Request Access button it has a modal screen where you can pick the Group instance.

In the **Client application name** field could you please follow the naming conventions below:

AS_{agencyname}_{application}(ExternalServiceProvider)_{instance}

Examples:

AS_Progressive_AMS1(ExternalServiceProvider)_nonprod

AS_Progressive_AMS1(ExternalServiceProvider)_prod

Once your subscription has been approved you should get a subscription email instructing you to login to the portal and find your client application credentials to start accessing the API. If the name of the application does not follow the naming guidelines, the request may be declined.
