


## Commercial Auto Quoting API

### Accessing the API

1. Clicking on the APIs tab will show the API Catalog with an API Group that your application can be subscribed to, gaining access to a suite of APIs.



2. To view the API documentation, click on the Group Details button.




- 3. Click the "Request Access" button to subscribe your app to use the API. When you click on the Request Access button, it has a modal screen where you can pick the Group instance.
- 4. In the Client application name field could you please follow the naming conventions below:


CL\_ NationalAccount\_{Agency}(ExternalServiceProvider)\_{instance}
Examples:

CL\_NationalAccount\_TestAgency(ExternalServiceProvider)\_nonprod

CL\_NationalAccount\_TestAgency(ExternalServiceProvider)\_prod




- 5. Once your subscription has been approved you should get a subscription email instructing you to login to the portal and find your client application credentials to start accessing the API. If the name of the application does not follow the naming guidelines, the request may be declined.
- 6. Login to the portal, go to the "My Applications" tab and click View to see your App's request status.



7. You can then verify your registered app has access to the API by looking in your My Applications tab and scrolling to the bottom of the Application page. In non-prod this is can be approved in a few minutes once we receive the request.



8. In Prod it will take longer (usually within 24 hours). You will get approval notification via email. Once approved, you'll be provided the Client Credentials (Client ID & Client Secret) which will be used to obtain the OAuth token.



Congratulations! You can now start calling the API!

#### Testing the API

Click the API details button next. Read through the API Documentation and then use the API Console Tab to test out the specific API that you are interested in and have been granted access to.
